

TRAINING ON GENDER ANALYSIS AND SMALL GRANT OPPORTUNITIES FOR REPRESENTATIVES OF CIVIL SOCIETY ORGANIZATIONS IN GEORGIA

If you are a civil society representative and are interested in gender statistics, research and analysis, then this opportunity is for you.

CRRC-Georgia, together with UN Women, is organizing a 5-day training (April 23-27) for civil society representatives working on human rights and gender equality issues in Georgia.

The aim of this initiative is to strengthen the capacity of civil society organizations on gender data analysis and research, empowering them to explore the aspects of human rights and gender equality.

The training will be held in Georgian language.

Who can apply?

- Representatives of civil society organizations working on human rights and/or gender equality issues, both from Tbilisi and from the regions, who are interested in gender equality analysis and research.
- Those who can fully attend the training in Tbilisi or near Tbilisi for 5 days (April 23-27, 2025).
- Preference will be given to representatives of women's organizations and small organizations operating in the regions.

How to design qualitative and quantitative research;



Conducting quantitative research and its stages;



Conducting qualitative research and its stages;



Combining quantitative and qualitative research (mixed methods) and analyzing data;



Interpreting and presenting gender data.


What is next?
